1. Introduction

The Advanced Science and Technology Research Center for Multimodal AI Communication (hereinafter referred to as “ASTREC”) of Universal Communication Research Institute, National Institute of Information and Communications Technology recognizes its social mission as a research institute who promotes research and development of speech translation technologies and hereby declares this Security Policy to properly manage information assets used for the R&D activities and strive to adhere to this Policy.

2. Compliance with Laws and Regulations

ASTREC will comply with domestic and international legal and regulatory requirements and applicable requirements related to information security upon handling information assets and personal information for R&D.

3. Application of Information Security Management System

ASTREC establishes an information security management system among the two laboratories: Multimodal Speech Communication Laboratory and Multilingual and Multicultural Communication Laboratory, defines and operates information security objectives, and continuously seek improvement.

4. Responses to Violations and Incidents

In the unlikely event that a violation of laws and regulations concerning information security, or an incident occurs, ASTREC shall respond appropriately in accordance with the regulations and ensure to prevent recurrence of such event.
